St. Dorothy Fielding Robot Competition Teams

Saint Dorothy School has joined the First Lego League and established two teams of fifth through eighth graders who are building and programming robots using Lego Mindstorm kits to compete against other schools in robotics challenges. The First Lego League is an international robotics program that seeks to interest children in science and technology. Adult coaches lead teams of up to ten children who, through collaborative and discovery learning, design, build, and program robots and research solutions to a theme determined annually.

This year's theme is "Senior Solutions." Teams must find ways to improve and maintain the quality of life of senior citizens by interviewing seniors and professionals who work closely with them. Then, they must invent a solution to a problem identified by their senior partners. The St. Dorothy's teams are working with Sr. Elizabeth

Ann and Fr. John Silcox. Additionally, they must build and program their robots to complete a set of tasks related to the theme on a playing field. At competitions, the students must also make presentations based on their research as well as demonstrate problem-solving, team-building, and collaboration strategies.

School parents Dorothy Sayers and Jenny Spinner are coaching the teams with the help of Jim Cordes and other parents who are lending their skills. Home & School Association fund-raising enabled the purchase of the robot kits and other start-up supplies needed to establish the teams.

St. Dorothy's two teams, RoDots and DotBots, will compete in a regional competition at The Franklin Institute on January 26, 2013.

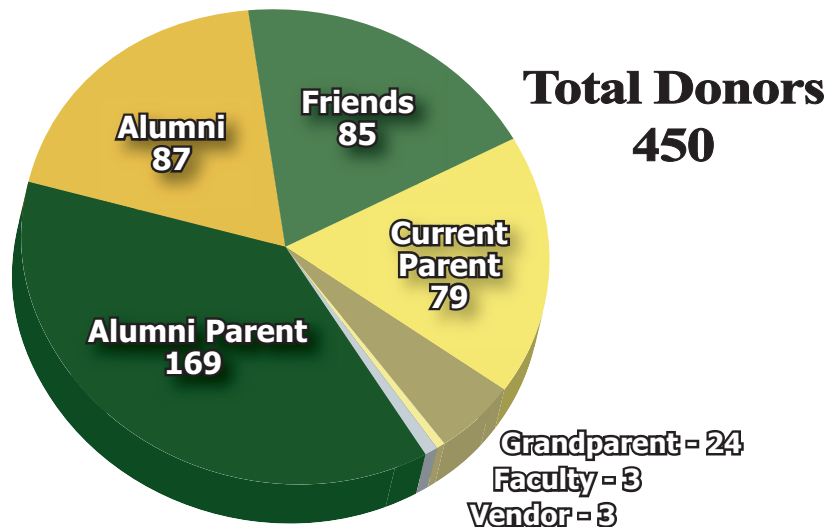

Celebrating a Silver Jubilee

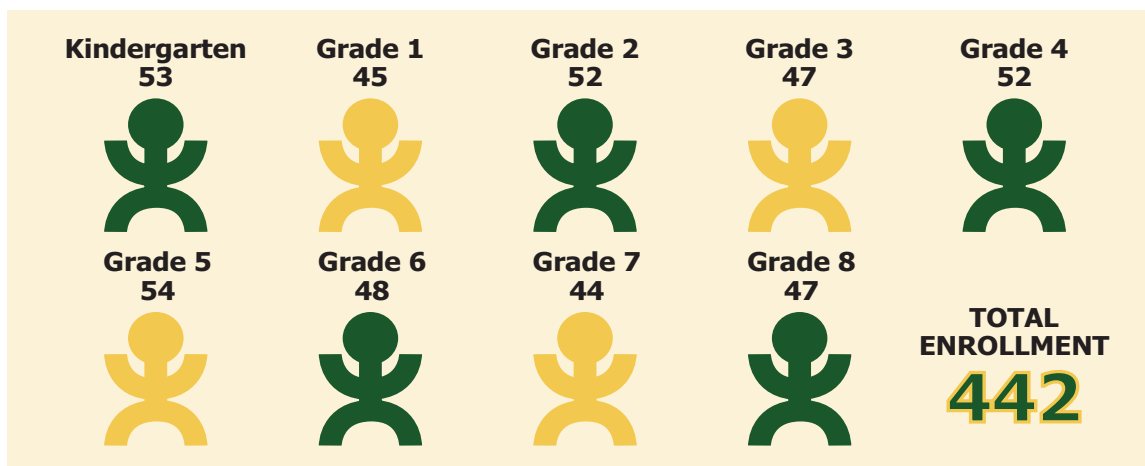

First in Math

We received a letter from Robert Sun, who is president of First in Math, our online math program that provides games and challenges for students to practice their math skills. He congratulated St. Dorothy School students for achieving a lofty goal of becoming a “Million Sticker School.” Only 55 of the more than 5,000 participating schools have earned this distinction, and St. Dorothy is one of them! Access to this special program is available to our students through the fundraising efforts of the Home & School Association.

Online Grading Program

Parents of students at St. Dorothy School are able to access

their child/children’s grades any time they wish through the use of an online grade book. This service allows parents to remain abreast of their child/children’s academic performance throughout the school year. This year, St. Dorothy School moved to a new grading system called **Option C**. The use of this resource is possible through your donations.

Year of Faith

In observance of the Year of Faith declared by Pope Benedict XVI, St. Dorothy School students will study a virtue each month and will be encouraged to incorporate virtues into their daily lives. They will be reminded that virtues are God’s grace working within us. Students’ learning will begin with the Theological virtues and move to the Cardinal virtues.

Parents will also be involved in this learning. A resource, explaining the virtue and scripture readings focusing on the virtue, will be sent home each month. Parents will be encouraged to spend time as a family discussing the resource.

Celebrating Mass

Beginning this past October, PREP (Parish Religious Education Program) and school families whose children are in the same grade began celebrating Sunday masses together. Each month pews are reserved at a 10 AM mass for a different grade so that the families can sit together. The hope of this initiative is to strengthen the bond between PREP and school families.
