

Pool Renovation Services

Renovating your swimming pool can be a matter of simply restoring it to its original luster by replacing all or parts of its coping, tile, plaster and decking with new materials. Or, if you wish, it can be an opportunity to upgrade your pool's look and functionality with new features.

If you so choose, AquaThority (rated A+ by the Better Business Bureau) will take full responsibility of your pool renovation. We will:

- personally inspect and assess your pool's condition
- advise you on your material and feature options
- prepare an itemized proposal of costs for each task
- personally execute and manage the entire project
- warranty our labor and material for 3 years





Renovation Components

The common pool renovation components include but are not limited to coping, tile, plaster, and decking.

Coping

Coping has many functions: provides pleasant seating for bathers; keeps storm water out of the pool; transitions to the surrounding decking to form a seamless meeting of the two bodies except where decking has moved; and, caps and hides the bond beam.

New coping entails:

- existing coping is removed along with its cement so that the bond beam is exposed
- new coping is set in cement directly on top of the bond beam, pitched away from the pool
- coping is pointed with gray cement (unless otherwise directed by the homeowner)

Coping materials include: safety grip or bull nose brick; flagstones such as Pennsylvania; imported stone like travertine; and, other products manufactured for coping applications.

Plaster

A desirable surface because of its smoothness and durability, white plaster is the most popular finish for pools and spas. Comprised of white marble dust and white cement at a ratio of 2 to 1, it's applied at a thickness of about a half-inch (.5").

New plaster entails:

- water-blasting paint, if it exists; thereafter, acid washing and cleaning the surface
- tap-testing the surface for hollow spots (known as pop-offs) and chipping as needed
 - applying bond-coat (primer) to the surface to which the new plaster will adhere
 - plaster is delivered to the pool via hose and sprayed over the bond coat
 - finishers hand trowel the plaster to an even, smooth and hardened surface

While white is the most popular and cost-effective plaster, there are alternative plasters which incorporate different aggregates such as quartz, pebble and bead.

Tile

The tile band beneath the coping is commonly 6". Its function is to hide the scum line and also protect the plaster. The trim tile which adorns the façade or the top of the steps and benches is typically 2" or 3" and serves as an identifier for swimmers.

Verona tile

New tile entails:

- existing tile is removed and the loose subsurface is chipped and cleaned
- cement foundation (brown coat) is applied and troweled to the surface
- new tile is set in white cement (thin-set) and grouted to match plaster color

Choose from over 100 domestic and imported pool tiles specifically manufactured to be frost proof and suitable for the severe weather conditions of the Northeast environment.



Decking

Typically pool decking is the area adjacent to, and surrounding, the in-ground pool but it can also expand to include patios and the like. While many forms of pool decking exist, the most common form is 4" of concrete on a 4" base of clean stone.

Although there are many decking options, AquaThority provides four basic decks:

- spray-deck veneer: applied over existing concrete deck
- concrete: formed and poured with stamped or broom finish
- wet-set: travertine, brick, and flagstone, e.g. Pennsylvania
- dry-set: brick, travertine, flagstone and interlocking pavers

The gap which separates the decking from the coping is a buffer against movement of the deck disrupting the coping; this gap should be caulked.
